Supply List & Floss Table

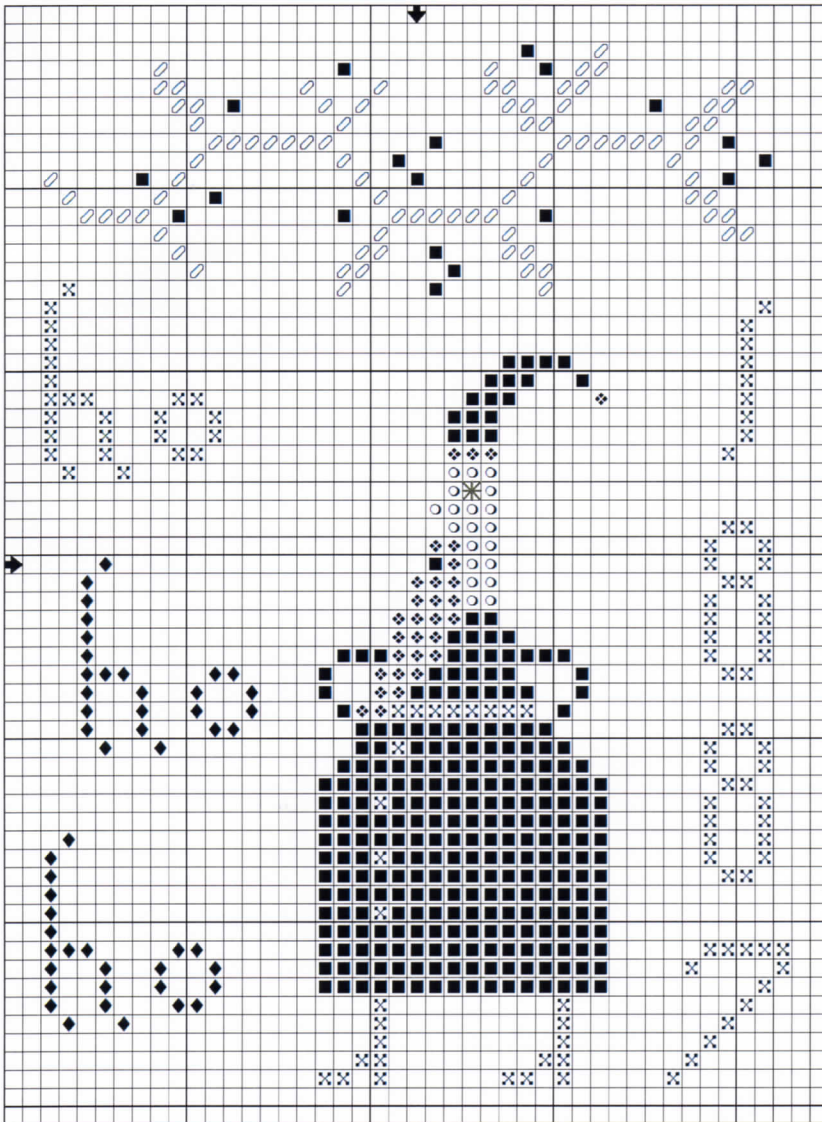
30 count Weeks Dye Works "Linen": 7" w x 8" h (allows for 2" linen on all sides of finished stitching)

Optional for aging needlework: walnut crystals, spray bottle, vinyl gloves, iron, towel

Stitching Instructions

- Stitch entire design with 1 strand of floss over 2 threads of linen.
- Santa's eye is an Algerian eyelet stitch, worked with 1 strand of 3787 over 2 threads of linen. Another option is to make a single cross stitch with 1 strand of 3787.



Aging Instructions (optional)

1. Heat iron to highest setting. (Note: I use an old iron that I do not use on clothing.)
2. Put on gloves. Mix 1/8 tsp. walnut crystals with 1 cup water in a small spray bottle.
3. Place needlework face up on an old towel that is doubled up to protect surface underneath. Spray aging solution *lightly* all over needlework. If you don't have a spray bottle, use a small piece of rag to blot aging solution on work.
4. Turn needlework face down and iron to set the stain.
5. Repeat until you get the desired look. Hint: spray/blot in random areas to create an old, stained look.

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
